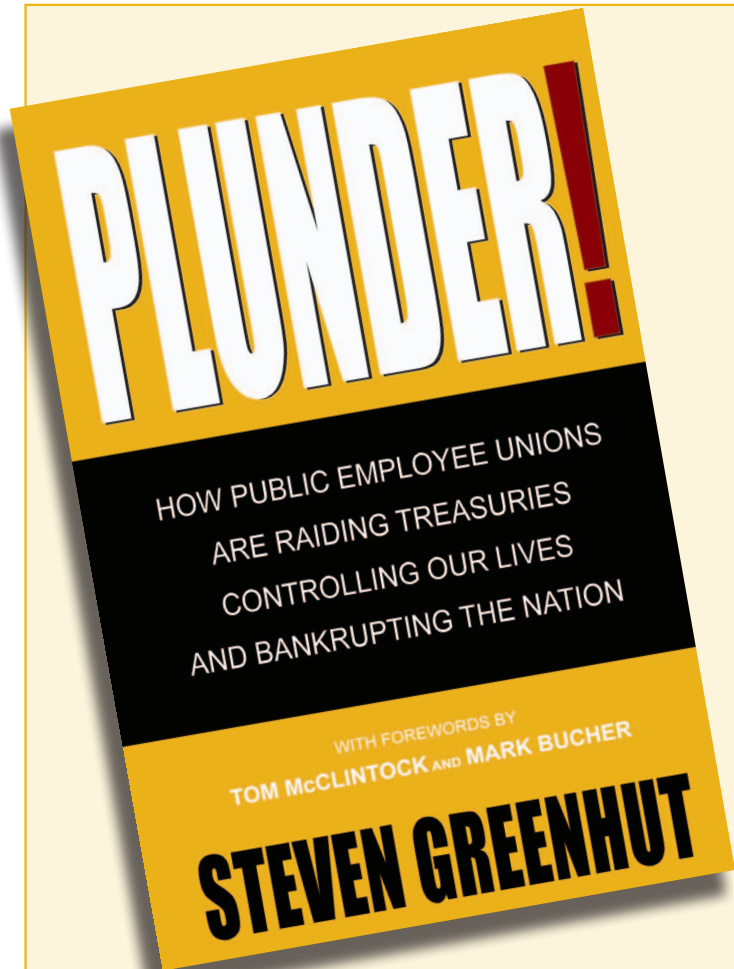

In 2005, Greenhut won the Institute for Justice's Thomas Paine Award for his writing promoting freedom. He is a senior fellow at the Goldwater Institute in Phoenix. His book on public employee unions was released in November, 2009. It is titled, *Plunder: How Public Employee Unions are Raiding Treasuries, Controlling our Lives and Bankrupting the Nation*. He graduated from George Washington University, is married and has three daughters.
